
静性道

sei sei dô

The way of peaceful sexuality



静 (sei): calm, peaceful, quiet

性 (sei) : sex, sexuality. This kanji is interesting because it has heart (left part) and life

(right part)

道 (dô): the way, the path

Seiseidô sounds very "Japanese" with the repetition « sei » (even if the word seiseidô is perfectly invented), because the Japanese are very fond of repetitions, which we see in their onomatopoeia for example.

The advantage of creating a Japanese sounding word is that in the Japanese language several kanji (of different meanings) can have the same pronunciation. Here are some other interesting kanji that are also pronounced "sei":

生 life, existence,

正 positivity, but also what is just, right, honest,

精 energy, vigour, vitality,

世 society, world.

There are therefore many possible variations on the word seiseidô, giving poetry and depth to the approach. In order to broaden the concept, from the personal to the collective and societal dimension, I have therefore retained three ways of considering seiseidô:

静性道: a way to a peaceful sexuality

静生道: a way to a peaceful living

静世道: a way to a peaceful society



Finally, two words that really exist in Japanese:

- 清清 (or 清々, the second sign being the one for repetition): sei sei This is the feeling of being refreshed, relieved.
- 正正堂堂 (or 正々堂々): seiseidôdô
 It's playing fair, putting your cards on the table, showing fair play.

Isn't that a nice programme for seiseidô?
